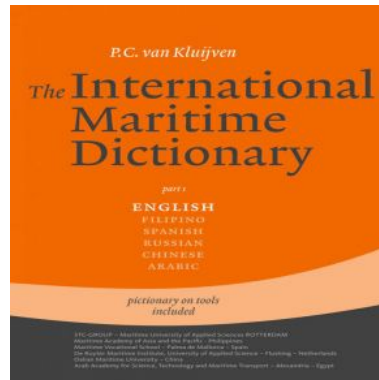
The International Maritime Dictionary - IMD is a Maritime English Dictionary that will form an indispensable tool in all your daily business activities. The IMD provides translations of English maritime-related idioms and expressions regarding seafaring, inland navigation, engineering, shipbuilding, safety, communication, chartering, insurance and logistics into the ten languages most frequently used in the international shipping industry:
